CORAL VIEWING & SNORKELLING TOUR

View the pristine beauty of one of the worlds untouched reef systems. Learn about this unique marine environment and discover a new world on our glass bottom boats. The two hour tour focuses on exploring the profuse coral seascape and introduces visitors to some of the more unusual lagoon inhabitants such as the endemic double-header wrasse, stingrays and turtles.

This tour provides an optional snorkelling experience at Erscott's Hole, or you can just relax on the boat and view the stunning diversity of this exotic marine location.

Experience fish and marine life in their coral reef habitat on a safe, comfortable and eco-friendly glass bottom boat charter.

SPECIALITY SNORKELLING TOUR


Join us on our two hour Speciality Snorkelling Tour to four or more of the lagoons most amazing coral gardens including:

Erscott's Hole – located on the inside of the western reef, and dominated by a luxuriant garden of staghorn coral, Erscott's Hole is famous for its Double Header Wrasse and Spangled Emperors.

Erscott's Reef – boasting the greatest coral density and diversity within the lagoon, Erscott's reef offers a range of snorkelling experiences, from the deep western tip of this reef to its shallow eastern side.

Comets Hole – an incredible variety of marine life is found in this deep coral hole, ranging from massive Black Stingrays to animated clown fish.

The Horseshoe – a shallow reef dominated by neon coloured corals and mesmerising Butterflyfish. This site is the perfect location for those learning to snorkel.



Snorkel within the calm pristine waters of the lagoon and marvel at the diversity of this reef environment and experience the greatest range of coral communities and fish fauna within the Island's stunning lagoon.

MT GOWER TREK & NATURAL HISTORY TOURS

BLACKBURN ISLAND NATURAL HISTORY TOUR

Come and visit Blackburn Island where you can meet numerous down-covered, Wedge-tailed Shearwater chicks. Located on the western edge of the lagoon, Blackburn Island provides a protected haven for not only seabirds but for unique insect and lizard species. This tour operates from February to April.

NORTH BAY & NORTH HEAD NATURAL HISTORY TOUR

Enjoy a relaxing glass bottom boat ride to North Bay whilst learning about the Islands fascinating maritime history. Walk through the North Bay palm forest then climb to the top of North Head and be amazed by the panoramic views from this volcanic ridgeline. Enjoy a stroll along North Bay beach and a short walk to the 'Old Gulch'.

This tour includes a snorkel at one of the lagoons beautiful coral holes and on return to our boatshed morning or afternoon tea.

MT GOWER TREK

Join Island Naturalist Dean Hiscox on the Mt Gower Trek. Dean was an Island Ranger for 16 years and his extensive knowledge will ensure a unique and memorable day in which you will learn about the Island's World Heritage values and its amazing natural history.

The Mount Gower Trek justly deserves its ranking as one of Australia's top day walks. Marvel at the breathtaking views of Balls Pyramid, Mt Lidgbird, the lagoon and the Island's northern settlement area. Taking approximately five hours to reach the summit at 875 metres and another four hours to return, this trek should not be taken lightly.
